10. To discuss the progress with the Fuel Charity Woodland.

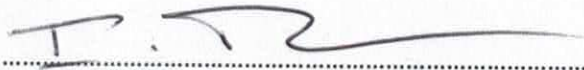
Mr Tasker has all the paperwork in place and he has the go-ahead to start, but it must be done before it gets too wet.
